Just 150m from the main street, bed and breakfast 'Amble at Hahndorf' awaits you with quiet, country scenes and wonderful gardens that create an atmosphere of peace and gentle romance.

Directions from Adelaide

- Travel time from the CBD: 20 minutes
- From Adelaide take the M1 Freeway and exit at the Hahndorf exit
- Drive towards Hahndorf (two kilometres)
- As you come into town Hereford Avenue is on your right (Udder Delights and Just Coffee are located on the corners)
- Amble at Hahndorf is on your right, 150 metres from the corner



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WREN

Amble Wren is a lovely, private, self-contained cottage for a couple, with its own deck overlooking lush gardens. An open-planned living area allows you to be part of the rural outlook. Watch the horses frolicking in the paddocks from your own private spa.



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OVER

Amble Over is a stylish, upstairs apartment for a couple. Experience the serenity of either the rural or garden views from either of your balconies. Your spacious bathroom includes a luxurious spa and a sweeping view over the rear paddocks. The front balcony provides a wonderful view over the gorgeous English-style garden.





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FERN

Amble Fern is a contemporary styled studio. With an additional bedroom (queen or twin beds) and two bathrooms, shower/spa and toilet/vanity, it can comfortably accommodate up to four. Relax in the spa or sit in your private courtyard with an English garden setting. Large windows provide views across a tranquil leafy garden.





Adelaide Hills Festivals & Events

Hahndorf in the Adelaide Hills is the ideal gateway to:

Fabulous Food and Wine Region - many 'cellar doors' for wine/olives/cheese etc in close proximity, too many to list - regional produce abounds - and the annual Adelaide Hills Wine Festival 'Crush' early in the year

Heysen - 'The Cedars' houses a great collection of Hans Heysen's remarkable paintings and drawings and his original studio still stands on the property

The Hahndorf Academy - regional arts and heritage centre housing four galleries, artist's studios, migration museum, retail gallery and art classes

Markets - country style with vast and varied arrays of goods and produce at various locations on most weekends

Oakbank Easter Racing Carnival - annually at Easter

Bay to Birdwood Classic - motoring cavalcade of cars from the past (annually - usually September)

National Motor Museum, Birdwood - a collection of important vintage, veteran and classic cars and motorcycles

The National Costume Museum, Lobethal - in the former Onkaparinga Woollen Mill is a collection of original gowns and suits from 1812 to 2000 - a secret that shouldn't be a secret!!

Lights of Lobethal - the largest community 'Christmas illumination' in the southern hemisphere - mid to late December (annually)

With walking trails, historical sites, galleries, restaurants, cafés, conservation parks, wildlife sanctuaries and golf courses, this is a very small selection of some of the events and attractions that occur in and around Hahndorf and the beautiful Adelaide Hills region - for more information, go to visitadelaidehills.com.au and understand why you may need to stay a little longer...
